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General Overview

Membership in the Georgia Junior Classical is not required for *Praetoria* participation.

Registration

1. Phase 1
 - a. Please fill in the registration form on the GJCL website accurately.

 - b. Make sure to have a first choice and an alternative choice *of the opposite sex*.

 - b. Once notified, please completely and accurately fill in the Permission/Media Release form and Medical form at the end of this document. **Please bring all forms and payment to Praetoria.**
 - c. Once registered you may make substitutions, PROVIDED THAT the substitution is of the same sex.

Rules and Regulations

Representatives will adhere to all Rock Eagle rules. Rock Eagle security will be on duty 24 hours a day. Regulations, which will be in effect during the convention, are:

1. JCL delegates are not allowed to drive vehicles during *Praetoria*.
2. No delegate may leave the Rock Eagle site until the end of *Praetoria*.
3. The use or possession of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illegal drugs, weapons or fireworks is strictly prohibited. Possession of alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs or fireworks constitutes a major infraction of the rules, and delegates will be sent home at their parents' expense.
4. Under no circumstances may window screens be removed. There will be a \$25 removal charge.
5. Any damage of Rock Eagle property is strictly prohibited. Disciplinary action will include financial remuneration for such damage or theft. All areas of the campus must be left in the same condition as found upon arrival.
6. Members of the opposite sex are not permitted in the same cabins.
7. All JCL representatives must be in their cabins at curfew.
8. It is recommended that no valuables be brought to Rock Eagle, as there is no method for securing these items.
9. Attendance at all events is mandatory for all delegates.
10. Swimming is prohibited.
11. Grills are not allowed on the Rock Eagle campus.
