

GJCL Appointed Officer Requirements

All candidates must submit the Papers of Candidacy prior to convention. Candidates should prepare to be interviewed by members of the current GJCL board. The interview will take place after Open Forum in the Hastings Building. Please dress presentably and appropriately. Send any questions concerning applications to the respective officer (editor@gjcl.org, historian@gjcl.org, webmaster@gjcl.org).

Editor

- Candidates should prepare to present some samples of their work (i.e. a newsletter or an article) for evaluation by the current editor.
- Candidates should have some experience with publishing softwares.

Historian

- Candidates should prepare to present some samples of their work (i.e. a scrapbook or photographs) for evaluation by the current historian.
- If the candidate intends on creating a traditional scrapbook if he/she is named historian, the candidate should bring samples of his/her artwork (paintings, models, etc.).
- Candidates intending on creating digital scrapbooks should be prepared to explain their work with scrapbooking programs.

Webmaster

- Candidates should be ready to present web- or technology-based media for evaluation by the current webmaster.
- Candidates should have some experience with programming or markup languages.
